New season of 'Top Chef' filmed in \$7M penthouse in One Brooklyn Bridge Park

"Top Chef" contestants will reportedly be staying in a waterfront penthouse at One Brooklyn Bridge Park similar to the one above.

Fancy chefs need fancy digs.

On the new season of Bravo's "Top Chef," premiering this Wednesday, the 18 contestants will be cooking up the drama in the second priciest apartment on the Brooklyn market, reports [the Real Deal](#).

Location: the waterfront penthouse suite at One Brooklyn Bridge Park, which is priced at a whopping \$7.25 million.

The Brooklyn Heights apartment has hardwood floors, 13-foot ceilings, and massive window displays featuring views of Manhattan, Brooklyn, the Statue of Liberty and the Brooklyn Bridge, according to [the One Brooklyn Bridge Park website](#).

And it wouldn't be complete without a pimped out kitchen, which comes complete with Italian wood cabinetry, a specially engineered quartz countertop, two wall ovens and a five burner stove.

According to the building's website, the chefs' new digs comes with a 3,000 square-foot gym, a virtual golf driving range, and a mini-theater.

And then there's the 1.3 miles of parkland surrounding the complex.
