THE eighth season of “Top Chef” is back in New York, but instead of living in Manhattan, the chef’testants will be living in Brooklyn at One Brooklyn Bridge Park’s Sky House.

“One Brooklyn Bridge Park was the ideal location for Top Chef,” said **Robert Levine**, CEO of RAL Companies, the project’s developer.

“The luxurious penthouse provided a nice escape for the cast, on the other side of the river, and gave the chef’testants the perfect place to rest and recharge.”

The chefs lived in a 4,638 s/f, four-bedroom waterfront triplex penthouse. Perched atop the 438-unit condominium, which is located within the 85-acre Brooklyn Bridge Park, the home is priced at \$7.25 million — the second most expensive apartment

in Brooklyn.

As if One Brooklyn Bridge Park was designed with the chefs in mind, the apartment features a custom built Italian kitchen by Dada. It is outfitted with appliances by Sub Zero and Bosch, including a double wall oven and five-burner cook top.
